Tacting "That is a cookie" More commonly known as labeling

Listener Responding

Nanny: "Please give me a cookie" Nanny Kid hands a cookie to nanny

The child does not have to say the word, but instead identify the item/action asked of them

Early (0-18mo):

- Beginning to select the correct item when asked
 - Nanny asks for items during play
 - If You're Happy and You Know It song (nanny models)

Intermediate (18-30mo):

- Performs actions when asked (clap hands)
 - If You're Happy and You Know It song (child performs action first)
- Follows noun + verb or verb + noun instructions
 - Give instructions to move in fun ways

Advanced (30-48mo):

- Selecting item by adjective (color, shape, size, etc)
 - Craft projects
 - During play (the big black train)

Intraverbals

Nanny: "What should we make today?"

Nanny Kid: "Cookies"

Turn taking pre conversational skills

Early (0-18mo):

- Mostly non-existent
 - Sing songs so they become familiar for later
 - Ready, Set...Go!

Intermediate (18-30mo):

- Fill in the blank phrases
 - Sing familiar songs & pause for them to fill in missing words
- Answering "Wh" questions
 - Hedbanz game

Advanced (30-48mo):

- Answering multiple questions around a single topic
 - After reading a book
 - 20 questions
